BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INTEGRATION

A new way of caring for your child that honors the connection between physical wellness and emotional health.

What is Behavioral Health Integration?

Your physical health has a powerful effect on your emotional health. Likewise, stress and poor lifestyle habits can harm your physical health. Behavioral Health Integration (BHI) is an approach to healthcare that focuses on this connection. A BHP is a member of your care team who is trained in the behavioral management of health problems. He or she works with you, your family, your child’s pediatrician, and other members of your care team to create a plan that meets all of your healthcare needs.

What to expect from Behavioral Health Integration.

- * Our office will be staffed with a Behavioral Health Provider (BHP), Dr. Timofey Galuza, who will work with your child’s pediatrician to coordinate care.
- * You will have contact with the Behavioral Health Provider at various appointments with your pediatrician when you visit the Oregon City Pediatric Building.
- * Your interactions with Dr. Galuza will be documented in the same medical record the clinic uses.
- * Your BHI visit will be billed to your insurance according to accepted guidelines.
- * If you have questions about your coverage, please contact your health insurance provider.

What can Behavioral Health Integration help with?

- ADHD
- Addiction
- Asthma
- Mental health conditions such as anxiety, depression, stress or grief
- Obesity
- Pain
- Sleep disturbances
- Behavioral/conduct concerns

Behavioral Health Integration	Mental Health Care
The visit takes place at your primary care clinic	The visit occurs at a mental health provider’s office
Visits are incorporated into regular appointments, lasting 15 – 30 minutes	Each visit is 45 to 60 minutes long
Care is “short term” lasting 1-6 appointments	Care is long term with ongoing treatment
The focus is on medical conditions	The focus is on mental health conditions
Care is typically billed under your medical insurance plan	Care is billed under your mental health insurance plan
BHI provider is part of your care team and works with your child’s pediatrician	There is limited coordination between your mental health provider and pediatrician
Care is documented in the office electronic medical record	Care is documented in a separate medical record
BHIP will refer you to an outside mental health provider as needed
